

# Information about the journal

## How to subscribe

The Scandinavian Journal of Information System (SJIS) is normally published once a year. There are two categories of subscribers to the journal: individuals and institutions. To subscribe to the journal as an individual, you have to register as a member of the IRIS association. Please, fill in your personal information at the member registration area at the web site of the SJIS (<http://iris.informatik.gu.se/sjis/>). The current fee is 300 SEK per year. The annual rate of subscription for institutions is 600 SEK. Enquiries are handled by e-mail at [sjis@informatics.gu.se](mailto:sjis@informatics.gu.se). Back issues can be ordered by e-mail.

## How to submit a paper

Authors are invited to submit original papers in MS-Word format to the editor-in-chief, Eric Monteiro, [eric.monteiro@idi.ntnu.no](mailto:eric.monteiro@idi.ntnu.no). If authors are in doubt about the suitability of their manuscript for the SJIS, authors are welcome to discuss their papers with any of the members of the editorial board before formal submission.

Once a manuscript is submitted, one of the four members of the editorial board will be assigned by the editor-in-chief to act as the editor of the manuscript. The reviewing process is double-blind in the sense that to the authors the referees are anonymous and to the referees the authors are anonymous. The SJIS is committed to produce high quality review reports that serve two purposes. First, it provides a means for evaluating papers with respect to their inclusion in the journal. Second, it provides substantive feedback to authors to assist them in improving their work.

After the review, the assigned editor and the editor-in-chief will arrive at a decision whether to publish the manuscript or not, or under which conditions the manuscript may later be published. The policy of the journal is that the reviewing process should take no longer than eight weeks from date of submission.
